What is CLC?

CASNR Living Community (CLC) is a living community for students enrolled in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. CLC is designed to provide CASNR students and opportunity to network with peers in similar classes as well as CASNR faculty.

Program benefits

Students develop a network of friends with which they have common interests as well as becoming acquainted with a number of faculty members in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. A sense of pride is built by contributing to others through community service. Students are encouraged to take part in the college experience through campus involvement and knowledge of available resources. As academic success is a primary concern, study groups in common courses will develop in this community.

Mentoring

CLC freshmen residents will build a mentoring relationship with upper-class students living in the same residence hall and serve as a built-in support system for members. The mentors are great resources for information about the OSU campus, CASNR and "where to eat", and other important information.

Networking

Members of the program are given the chance to meet the faculty on a one-on-one basis. Each floor in CLC will have a team of three faculty mentors that will work with this community through Faculty dinners, barbecues, and discussions to facilitate open lines of communication between students and faculty members.

Social Activities

Of course, this community will have fun with anything they do. Members can participate in Homecoming and Ag Week activities. Other opportunities to get together as a group may include attending allied arts events, playing intramural sports, or simply having dinner and watching movies.

Living Experience

As of this year, members of CLC are housed on the 1st and 2nd floors of CASNR Village. This residence hall provides both double and private suites. The 2008-09 cost of an OSU suite-style residence hall is \$2,761 (double w/ private bedroom) or \$2,911 (private suite) per semester.
